5. How could we improve the course?

Comments:

- Too intensive last week (i.e., place presentations of individual project the week before).
- Presentations of individual project before Gotland.
- Work load is biased towards the end of the course.
- Subdivide the course into two parts (individual project versus lectures)
- Could be very useful to see the bottom sides of the boxes through a glass window (taphonomy exercise).
- Review of fossils, the fossil record and what took place during different periods (one student).
- Assign relevant course literature chapters (instead of entire book).
- Ensure guest lectures are of high quality.

6. Potential views on the lectures?

Comments:

- In some lectures with 3 or 6 slides on one page, resolution was not enough to see all details.
- Easy to understand☺
- Good lectures!
- Much better when slides are printed out to annotate.

7. Potential views on the exercises/labs?

Comments:

- Data analysis lab(guest lectures) seemed dull and not very useful.
- Taphonomy lab was amazing!
- A chance to handle a wider range of fossils could be nice.
- I liked them.
- Good, more!
- Trilobite exercise = good, but perhaps we should have reviewed the parts in class + had a lecture about it.
